- Format

  - General procedures, or detailed procedures
  - Step by step for analyzing common measures promoted by PSM
  - Who performs what step and when

## Analysis Procedure Examples

- Most analysis procedures are program specific or organizational specific
- Could collect examples together but would need to make them releasable first

## Example Procedure for ROI

- What is my ROI for producing Widget?
  - What is my expected ROI (Expected Revenue / Expected Investment)?
  - What is my projected ROI (Actual Investment / Updated Expected Revenue)?
  - What is my actual ROI (Actual Investment / Actual Revenue)?
    - May be done incrementally
  - Investment = Labor, facilities, raw material, overhead including travel and training, technical investment, etc
  - Revenue = amount of product \* price

## Summary (cont.)

- Reached agreement that analysis procedures should be part of spec tables
- Agreed completion of spec tables for measures identified in ICM table would satisfy the need
